

Supply List

Fabric Requirements

All fabric must be 100% quilting cotton, unwashed (*this helps maintain consistency when sewing fabrics*).

For a traditional quilt size, you will need:

- **Interfacing:** 8 panels of Quiltsmart interfacing (116 arcs) – *provided in the required kit that accompanies this class.*
- **Clean and Tear Interfacing** – I suggest bringing your roll – Will need this during our 2nd class
- **Arcs:** $\frac{3}{4}$ yard total using 6 different medium and light fabrics.
- **Jewels (center squares):** $\frac{1}{2}$ yard each for 2 darker fabrics or $\frac{1}{4}$ yard each for 4 darker fabrics.
- **Background fabric:** 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards. Beth used the same fabric as the arcs for hers.
- **Binding:** $\frac{3}{4}$ yard.
- 20 x 20 layered quilt sandwich in scrap fabric – Will need this during our 3rd class

There's no prep work required before class — all cutting and measuring will be done together during our sessions. The only work done at home will be the homework assignments between classes.

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Tools to Bring

- Rotary cutter
- 3 different sized Quilting rulers: at least one larger than 12.5", plus 6.5" x 24" and 6.5" x 12"
- Pins or clips
- Seam ripper

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- Marking tools (Frixion pen, chalk pencil, etc.)
- Thread snips
- Microtex needle 80/12
- Fabric scissors
- Paper scissors
- Quiltsmart Double Wedding Ring Template (provided for purchase at the Old Country Store)
- Teflon pressing mat (provided for purchase at the Old Country Store) or freezer paper

Thread

- Aurifil thread in cream or gray (recommended for piecing)
- Bobbin pre-wound with preferred thread

Machine Setup

- Machines can be provided, but attendees are encouraged to bring their own.
- Preferred setup includes: sewing machine with table, module, cords, foot control, and manual.
- **Bernina presser feet:** #97, 97C, or 97D. and #71
 - If using another brand, choose a ¼” foot you’re comfortable with.
- **Bernina stitch plate:** single hole 0mm (if available) or regular 9mm.
- Temporary fabric marker or pencil.
- Be prepared to thread your own machine.
- Mini demo will include adjusting your machine for a **scant ¼” seam**.

Suggested Extras

- Pressing bar

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- Notebook or printed paper for demo notes.
- Light snack or beverage.
